


How to get to Peter Canisius House

Peter Canisius House is located at 102 Mona Vale Road, Pymble, NSW 2037, opposite Dalrymple Hay Nature Reserve and approximately 100 meters past Telegraph Road, on the left-hand side heading eastbound. Access can also be gained from Ganmain Road off Telegraph Road. Parking is available onsite on the old tennis courts at the front of the site.





PUBLIC TRANSPORT

TRAIN: From the Airport catch the train to Central Station. Change trains.

From Central Station catch a train along the North Shore Line (usually from Platform 16 at Central but check indicator boards), which stops at Gordon Station. Trains also reach Gordon from Hornsby, Chatswood and the Central Coast.

BUS: Forest Coach Line buses 195 run from Gordon to St Ives, 196 and 197 Gordon to Mona Vale. The bus stops at the front entrance of Peter Canisius House. You can also walk from Pymble station along Alma Street, then left into Station Street and right into Telegraph Road. This takes approximately 15 minutes.

TAXI: From the Airport, a Taxi may cost in excess of \$100.00. There are Taxi's available from Gordon Station if you catch the train to Gordon. The taxi from Gordon to Peter Canisius House will only take 5-10 minutes, and should cost no more than about \$20.00.

WALK: If walking from the Train Station, Pymble is the closest station to get the train to. From Pymble Station, walk along Alma Street to join Station Street. Continue along Station Street and turn right onto Telegraph Road. From Telegraph Road, continue to a left turn into Ganmain Road. Our driveway is the 4th one along on the right, just before Blackbutt Reserve. Walk up the drive and around to the front of the building to reception.
