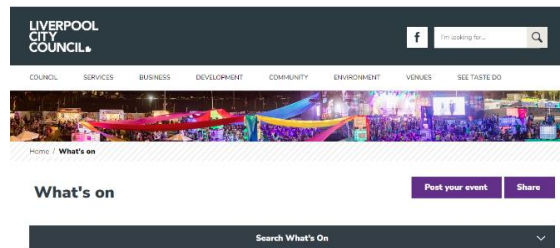

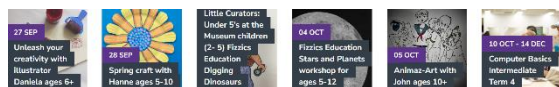

As Luca and the inmates retrace the events and the web of family ties surrounding the incident, the unexpected visit of Luca's estranged daughter (Denise Tantucci) will force him to question the relationship between identity, memory, and love. 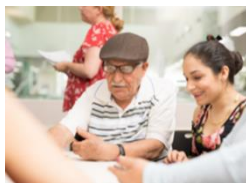
Open daily for the duration of the exhibition, a hands-on art-making workshop suitable for all ages will accompany Woolfe's dynamic homage to the Australian Raven.

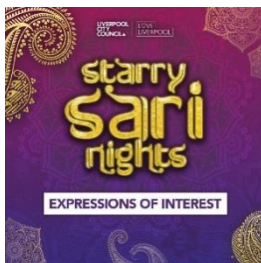
