The online visa application implemented through the visa web portal <u>www.srilankaevisa.lk</u> has been deactivated with immediate effect.

Until further notice, all applicants should follow the details below when applying for a visa: (You must hold a passport valid for a minimum period of six months from the date you arrive in Sri Lanka)

1. Visit Visa (30 Days Single Entry)

Available on arrival at the port of entry.

Special Note: Nationals from Afghanistan, Syria, Ghana, Nigeria, Pakistan, Cameroon, Ivory Coast, North Korea, and Myanmar can apply for a visa from the Head Office of the Department of Immigration and Emigration by sending a representative who is residing in Sri Lanka.

2. Visa-Free Countries

Nationals of China, India, Indonesia, Russia, Thailand, Malaysia, and Japan have the facility to obtain a visa free of charge with effect from 01 October 2024
